
2 Esdras 13: 40-45

- 40. Those are the ten tribes, which were carried away prisoners out of their own land in the time of Osea the king, whom Salmanasar the king of Assyria led away captive, and he carried them over the waters, and so came they into another land.
- 41. But they took this counsel among themselves, that they would leave the multitude of the heathen, and go forth into a fu rther country, where never mankind dwelt,
- 42. That they might there keep their statutes, which they never kept in their own land.
- 43. And they entered into Euphrates by the narrow places of the river.
- 44. For the most High then shewed signs for them, and held still the flood, till they were passed over.
- 45. For through that country there was a great way to go, namely, of a year and a half: and the same region is called Arsareth.













Deuteronomy 28:30-36



"The 10 tribes wives were raped by the Spanish conquistadors. They built houses they could not live in. They planted plenteous vineyards they could not enjoy."
- 31. Thine ox shall be slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass shall be violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep shall be given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue them.
- 32. Thy sons and thy daughters shall be given unto another people, and thine eyes shall look, and fail with longing for them all the day long: and there shall be no might in thine hand.



33. The fruit of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a nation which thou knowest not eat up; and thou shalt be only oppressed and crushed alway:

336. The LORD shall bring thee, and thy king which thou shalt set over thee, unto a nation 5 which neither thou nor thy fathers have known; and there shalt thou serve other gods, wood and stone.





And thou shalt become an astonishment, a proverb, and a byword, among all nations whither the LORD shall lead thee. A proverb and a byword means your nationality would be changed into a mockery, an insult. The 10 Tribes of Israel are called 'INDIANS" today which is a latin word meaning "Servants/Slaves".

Deuteronomy 28:49

The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, as swift as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;





THIS MEANS YOU MUST CONFESS AND FORSAKE YOUR SINS The word "sin" means breaking God Laws.

1 John 3:4

Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

Leviticus 26:40-42

- 40. If they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto me;
- 41. And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:
- 42. Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land.

- 7. And the swine [pig], though he divide the hoof, and be clovenfooted, yet he cheweth not the cud; he is unclean to you.










8. Of their flesh shall ye not eat, and their carcase shall ye not touch; they are unclean to you.







This is an example of a hoof




This is an example of a cloven "split" hoof

Animals that chew the cud (such as cattle, deer, goats, cows, oxen giraffer and sheep), cud is the food brought up into the mouth from the first stomach called the rumen and chewed again.

DIETARY LAWS FOR FISH

9. These shall ye eat of all that are in the waters: whatsoever hath fins and scales in the waters, in the seas, and in the rivers, them shall ye eat.









10. And all that have not fins and scales in the seas, and in the rivers, of all that move in the waters, and of any living thing which is in the waters, they shall be an abomination unto you: 11. They shall be even an abomination unto you; ye shall not eat of their flesh, but ye shall have their carcases in abomination.

12. Whatsoever hath no fins nor scales in the waters, that shall be an abomination unto you.

Leviticus 17:10-14

- 10. And whatsoever man there be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of blood; I will even set my face against that soul that eateth blood, and will cut him off from among his people.
- 11. For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.
- 12. Therefore I said unto the children of Israel, No soul of you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger that sojourneth among you eat blood.
- 13. And whatsoever man there be of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, which hunteth and catcheth any beast or fowl that may be eaten; he shall even pour out the blood thereof, and cover it with dust.
- 14. For it is the life of all flesh; the blood of it is for the life thereof: therefore I said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall eat the blood of no manner of flesh: for the life of all flesh is the blood thereof: whosoever eateth it shall be cut off.









EAT IN MODERATION... DON'T BE GREEDY

Ecclesiasticus 31:16-20

- 16. Eat as it becometh a man, those things which are set before thee; and devour not, lest thou be hated.
- 17. Leave off first for manners' sake; and be not unsatiable, lest thou offend.
- 18. When thou sittest among many, reach not thine hand out first of all.
- 19. A very little is sufficient for a man well nurtured, and he fetcheth not his wind short upon his bed.
- 20. Sound sleep cometh of moderate eating: he riseth early, and his wits are with him: but the pain of watching, and choler, and pangs of the belly, are with an unsatiable man.











Job 40:7

Gird up thy loins now like a man: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me."

Leviticus 19:27

Ye shall not round the corners of your heads, neither shalt thou mar the corners of thy beard.

Leviticus 21:5

They shall not make baldness upon their head, neither shall they shave off the corner of their beard, nor make any cuttings in their flesh.

- 5. When they told it unto David, he sent to meet them, because the men were greatly ashamed: and the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and then return.

2 Thessalonians 3:10

For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

Proverbs 6:6-11

- 6. Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise:
- 7. Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler,
- 8. Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest.
- A9. How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard? when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep?

Ecclesiasticus 25:22

A woman, if she maintain her husband, is full of anger, impudence, and much reproach.

HOW TO DRESS

Ecclesiasticus 19: 29-30

29. A man may be known by his look, and one that hath understanding by his countenance, when thou meetest him.

30. A man's attire [clothing], and excessive laughter, and gait [walk], shew what he is.



WEAR FRINGES



Numbers 15:38-40

38. Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a ribband of blue:

39. And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring: 40. That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your God.

Zephaniah 1:8

And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD's sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with **strange apparel**.







MEN DO NOT COVER YOUR HEAD WHEN YOU DEAL WITH THE SCRIPTURES

1 Corinthians 11: 4

Every man praying or prophesying, having his head covered, dishonoureth his head.

1 Corinthians 11:7

For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man. GOD IS ABOUT ORDER

1 Corinthians 11:3

But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.

Ezekiel 34:31

And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord GOD.

Genesis 18:19

For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

1 Timothy 3:5

(For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?)

GET A PLACE TO LIVE

Ecclesiasticus 29: 21-28

- 21. The chief thing for life is water, and bread, and clothing, and an house to cover shame.
- 22. Better is the life of a poor man in a mean cottage, than delicate fare in another man's house
- 23. Be it little or much, hold thee contented, that thou hear not the reproach of thy house.
- 24. For it is a miserable life to go from house to house: for where thou art a stranger, thou darest not open thy mouth.
- 25. Thou shalt entertain, and feast, and have no thanks: moreover thou shalt hear bitter words:
- 26. Come, thou stranger, and furnish a table, and feed me of that thou hast ready.
- 27. Give place, thou stranger, to an honourable man; my brother cometh to be lodged, and I have need of mine house.
- 28. These things are grievous to a man of understanding; the upbraiding of houseroom, and reproaching of the lender.



When a women's menstrual cycle begins she is unclean/no sex for seven days.

Leviticus 15:19

And if a woman have an issue, and her issue in her flesh be blood, she shall be put apart seven days: and whosoever toucheth her shall be unclean until the even. No sex during cycle

Leviticus 18:19

Also thou shalt not approach unto a woman to uncover her nakedness, as long as she is put apart for her uncleanness.

Leviticus 20:18

And if a man shall lie with a woman having her sickness, and shall uncover her nakedness; he hath discovered her fountain, and she hath uncovered the fountain of her blood: and both of them shall be cut off from among their people.

CLEANLINESS

Esther 2: 12

Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, (for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with other things for the purifying of the women.



COVER HEAD

Genesis 24: 64-65

64. And Rebekah lifted up her eyes, and when she saw Isaac, she lighted off the camel.
65. For she had said unto the servant, What man is this that walketh in the field to meet us? And the servant had said, It is my master: therefore she took a vail, and covered herself.

Judith 10: 3

And pulled off the sackcloth which she had on, and put off the garments of her widowhood and washed her body all over with water, and anointed herself with precious ointment, and

braided the hair of her head, and put on a tire upon it, and put on her garments of gladness, wherewith she was clad during the life of Manasses her husband.





1 Corinthians 11: 5-6

- 5. But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with her head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven.
- 6. For if the woman be not covered, let her also be shorn: but if it be a shame for a woman to be shorn or shaven, let her be covered.

Isaiah 3:20-22

- 20. The bonnets, and the ornaments of the legs, and the headbands, and the tablets, and the earrings,
- 21. The rings, and nose jewels,
- 22. The changeable suits of apparel, and the mantles, and the wimples, and the crisping pins.

Numbers 5:18

And the priest shall set the woman before the LORD, and uncover the woman's head, and put the offering of memorial in her hands, which is the jealousy offering: and the priest shall have in his hand the bitter water that causeth the curse:

Zephaniah 1:8

And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD's sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with strange apparel.



NO SEX FOR FORTY DAYS AFTER GIVING BIRTH TO A BOY / NO SEX FOR EIGHTY DAYS AFTER GIVING BIRTH TO A GIRL

Leviticus 12: 2-5

- 2. Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a woman have conceived seed, and born a man child: then she shall be unclean seven days; according to the days of the separation for her infirmity shall she be unclean.
- 3. And in the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.
- 4. And she shall then continue in the blood of her purifying three and thirty days; she shall touch no hallowed thing, nor come into the sanctuary, until the days of her purifying be fulfilled.
- 5. But if she bear a maid child, then she shall be unclean two weeks, as in her separation: and she shall continue in the blood of her purifying threescore and six days.





DRESS MODESTLY



Timothy 2:9

In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;

FRINGES AND A BORDER OF BLUE

Number 15:38-40

38. Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a ribband of blue:

39. And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring: 40. That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your God.

WOMEN DO NOT WEAR PANTS/BREECHES

Deuteronomy 22:5

The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination unto the LORD thy God. The priests had to wear linen pants/breeches

Exodus 28: 41-42

- 41. And thou shalt put them upon Aaron thy brother, and his sons with him; and shalt anoint them, and consecrate them, and sanctify them, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office.
- 42. And thou shalt make them linen breeches to cover their nakedness; from the loins even unto the thighs they shall reach: Do not dress like a whore

Proverbs 7: 10-11

- 10. And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart.
- 11. (She is loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house:

Leviticus 19: 29

Do not prostitute thy daughter, to cause her to be a whore; lest the land fall to whoredom, Jand the land become full of wickedness.



LEARN TO BE SILENT



34. Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law.

35. And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church.

1 Timothy 2:11-12

- 11. Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection.
- 12. But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

MARRIAGE



Hebrews 13:4

Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge.

1 Timothy 5:14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully

Exodus 22:16

And if a man entice a maid that is not betrothed, and lie with her, he shall surely endow her to be his wife. Proof of marriage







Tobit 7:14

And called Edna his wife, and took paper, and did write an instrument of covenants, and sealed it. Instrument of Covenant

Ecclesiasticus 42:10

In her virginity, lest she should be defiled and gotten with child in her father's house; and having an husband, lest she should misbehave herself; and when she is married, lest she should be barren.

1 Corinthians 7:28

But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you will have trouble when married

MAN IS THE HEAD OF THE WIFE

1 Corinthians 11:3

But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God.

Ephesians 5:22-23

- 22. Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.
- 23. For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

Colossians 3:18-19

- في 18. Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.
 - 19. Husbands, love your wives, and be not bitter against them.







Ecclesiasticus 26:7

An evil wife is a yoke shaken to and fro: he that hath hold of her is as though he held a scorpion.

Ecclesiasticus 30:1-13

- 1. He that loveth his son causeth him oft to feel the rod, that he may have joy of him in the end. 2. He that chastiseth his son shall have joy in him, and shall rejoice of him among his acquaintance.
- 3. He that teacheth his son grieveth the enemy: and before his friends he shall rejoice of him. 4. Though his father die, yet he is as though he were not dead: for he hath left one behind him that is like himself.
- 5. While he lived, he saw and rejoiced in him: and when he died, he was not sorrowful.
- 6. He left behind him an avenger against his enemies, and one that shall requite kindness to his friends.
- 7. He that maketh too much of his son shall bind up his wounds; and his bowels will be troubled at every cry.
- 8. An horse not broken becometh headstrong: and a child left to himself will be wilful.

Exodus 16:23



Nehemiah 10:31

And if the people of the land bring ware or any victuals on the Sabbath day to sell, that we would not buy it of them on the Sabbath, or on the holy day: and that we would leave the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt.





15. In those days saw I in Judah some treading wine presses on the Sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all manner of burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the Sabbath day: and I testified against them in the day wherein they sold victuals.

- 16. There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the Sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.
- 17. Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing is this that ye do, and profane the Sabbath day?
- 18. Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the Sabbath.
- 19. And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the Sabbath, I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the Sabbath: and some of my servants set I at the gates, that there should no burden be brought in on the Sabbath day.

*THE SABBATH AS WELL AS THE NEW MOONS AND ALL THE HOLY DAYS OF THE MOST HIGH ARE HOLY CONVOCATIONS MEANING ASSEMBLIES AND WE ARE NOT TO WORK. HOWEVER THERE IS GRACE CONCERNING WORK OUTSIDE YOUR CONTROL, MEANING YOUR JOB MAY ORDER YOU TO WORK ON THESE DAYS.
